**Roles and Responsibilities**

**Student Welfare Coordinator:**

1. Plan and implement welfare activities.
2. Guide students regarding university welfare schemes.
3. Coordinate with college administration for student support initiatives.
4. Maintain records of welfare activities conducted.

**Student Welfare Clerk:**

1. Assist in documentation and record maintenance.
2. Support communication and coordination related to welfare activities.
3. Maintain student welfare data and reports



## Major MUHS Student Welfare Schemes

- 1) Earn & Learn Scheme (कमवा व शिका योजना)  
Purpose: Financial support to needy students while gaining work experience.  
Benefit: Up to approx. ₹16,000 per academic year (about ₹2,000/month for 8 months).  
How it works: Students do assign college/hospital-related work (usually ~2 hrs./day), and receive a stipend.  
Eligibility: UG students with parent's annual income  $\leq$  ₹6 lakh; not available for PG, interns, NRI, or outside Maharashtra.
- 2) Dhanwantari Vidyadhan Yojana (धनवन्तरी विद्याधन योजना)  
Purpose: Scholarship support for economically weaker students in health sciences.  
Benefit: Financial assistance (amount can vary; often up to ₹30,000 approx.).  
Eligibility: Students from lower-income families who have taken educational loans, plus other criteria as per MUHS norms.
- 3) Savitribai Phule Scholarship for Girls (सावित्रीबाई फुले छात्रवृत्ती)  
Purpose: To support female students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.  
Benefit: Financial scholarship amount based on university guidelines.  
Eligibility: Girls enrolled in MUHS-affiliated UG/PG courses meeting income criteria.
- 4) Sanjeevani Student Security Scheme (संजेवनी विद्यार्थी सुरक्षा योजना)  
Purpose: Provides health/medical security and financial assistance if the student suffers serious illness or is hospitalized.  
Coverage: Typically benefits in case of critical health events; specifics depend on MUHS policy and documentation.
- 5) Bahishal Shikshan Mandal Yojana  
Purpose: Awareness and skill-building around issues like anti-ragging, stress management, women empowerment, disaster management, etc.  
Activities: Lectures, demonstrations, and guidance sessions for overall student welfare.



6) **Book Bank Scheme**

**Purpose:** Provides textbooks and academic resources on loan to students who may not afford them.

**Benefit:** Helps students reduce study material costs.

7) **Student Sports Scholarship / Cultural Support Schemes**

**Purpose:** Incentives and recognition for students participating in sports or cultural events at university/state level.

**Benefit:** Scholarships or support tied to performance/activity
